PERCENTAGE PLANNER

WordGirl is usually saving the bank from being robbed by villains like the meat-throwing Butcher. But now that he's behind bars, she can ask the bank teller about **saving**, **sharing**, and **spending** the money she made by doing chores around the house. The bank teller is helping other kids do the same thing. Can you help WordGirl and the bank teller solve these problems? *Show your work on separate paper!*

TJ wants to save 30% of his money and share 15% of it. What percentage does he have left to **spend**?

- Scoops' grandfather gave him \$25 for his birthday. If Scoops wants to share 20% of his money, how much of his gift should he give away?
- 3 Violet earned \$10 for doing chores. She spent \$3 and gave \$3 to a local charity. What percentage of her money did Violet **save**?
 - Victoria chooses to save 25% of her allowance, so every week she puts \$1.25 into her piggy bank. What is Victoria's total allowance?
 - Ms. Davis's class raised \$100 by holding a bake sale. They spent 5% on signs for advertising, decided to save 25% for their class trip, and gave the rest to an animal shelter. How much money did they give the animal shelter?

A smart percentage plan might look like this:

- Save 40%
- Share 20%
- Spend 40%
